NAPLAN

These national tests provide information about student achievement in Literacy and Numeracy. They help monitor the performance levels of all students across every state and territory. The NSW Department of Education and Communities uses these results to make system-wide decisions related to literacy and numeracy targets. Similarly, schools make informed decisions about planning and resources to improve student achievement. In the classroom, teachers use the data to reflect on and adjust their programs to better meet the learning needs of individual students or groups of students.

The data from the NAPLAN test results gives schools the ability to compare their students' achieve-

ments against national standards and student achievement in other states and territories. The NAPLAN test results provide information on how students are progressing, and support improvements in teaching and learning.

NAPLAN data is one of many measures used to assess student progress throughout the year. It is the only National measure used and as a result casts a significant shadow. These tests are a snap shot of student progress at a single point in time.
