To access the program each student will need to return the attached permission note, giving consent to have the assessment undertaken.

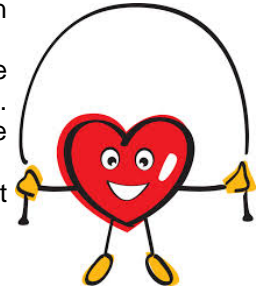
