#### Principal's Message

This term sees a few changes at Tarago Public School. I would like to welcome two new members of staff. Mrs Barbara Nell and Mrs Vanessa Deaton.

Mrs Nell will be undertaking the role of Release from Face to Face teaching (RFF) and Library. She will be at school each Tuesday and every second Friday. Mrs Deaton will be taking over as our Learning and Support Teacher and will be at school each Tuesday. Both come to us with experience and expertise in their area and I am sure Tarago PS will gain a great deal from their presence.

Next week is the Goulburn Community of Public Schools annual concert. Tarago PS will be again proudly taking part in this event.
