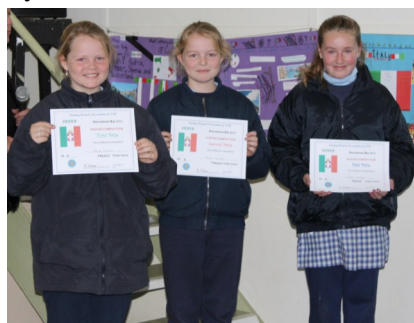
CWA Poster Winners

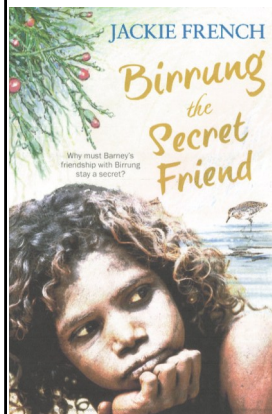


News from the Primary Room
