## News from 3-6

This week in Science, students have been investigating the properties of materials. They conducted an experiment in which they added vinegar to milk, causing the mixture to separate into a solid and a liquid. Next, they strained the solid, a protein called casein, from the liquid and moulded the casein into a shape. Year 2 students had the opportunity to conduct this experiment yesterday during their orientation time. While in the 3-6 classroom, Year 2 students also investigated the properties of 3D shapes by creating their own. Last Friday, Kindergarten to Year 6 participated in sport altogether. Everyone enjoyed learning the steps of The Heel-Toe-Polka and almost have it mastered after one session of Dance. Thanks to Lucy for leading the entire school for the "Nutbush".

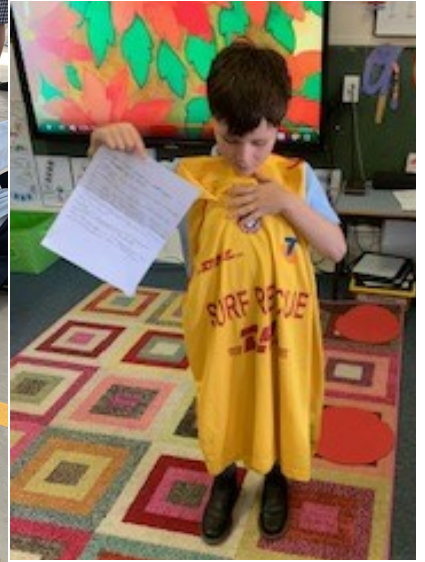

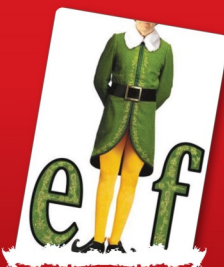
