

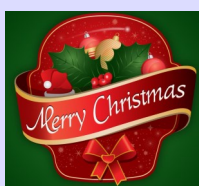

News from K-2

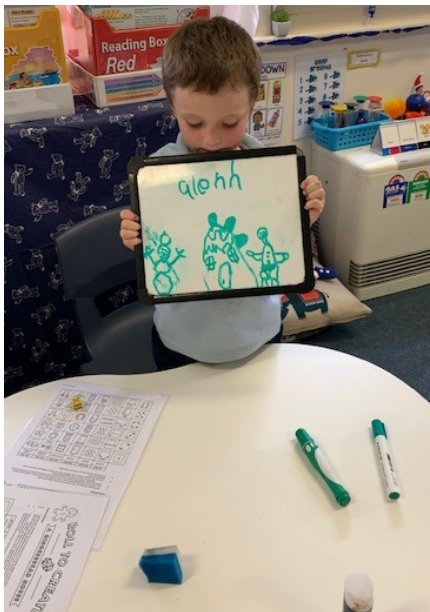
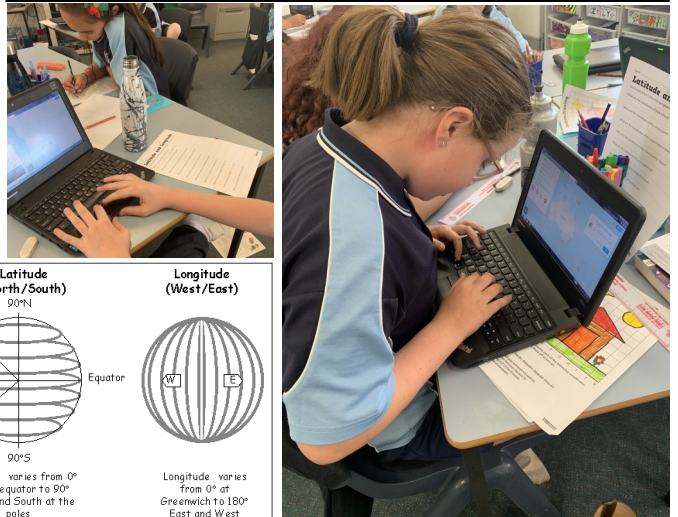
