Some work K-2 having been doing for Harmony week. We have been using orange paper and crayons as this is the colour that represents Harmony Day.

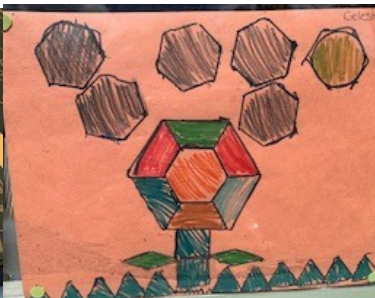

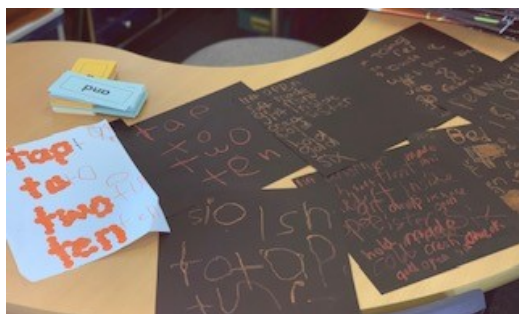
