Tech. Corner

Today, 3-6 students completed a design challenge using Lego EV3. The challenge was to create a vehicle that could stop automatically at something that was in its way and to reverse back from the object. All four groups were successful in completing the challenge. Having their vehicle stop 4cm from the object and then reverse 10cm.

This task involved the use of an ultra-sonic sensor and simulated the design of a driverless car.

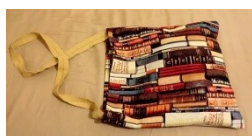


Voluntary School Contributions

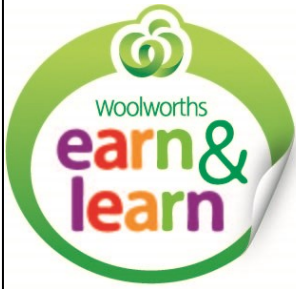
