### NAPLAN

Next week, year 3 and 5 students will undertake NAPLAN testing. This will be spread over Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, and will cover Reading, Spelling, Grammar, Punctuation, Writing and Numeracy.

NAPLAN tests skills in literacy and numeracy that are developed over time through the school curriculum.

### Sport and Recreation Camp!
