News from K-2

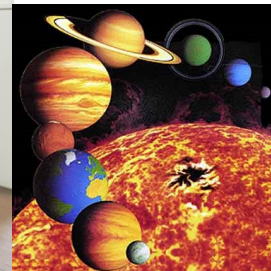
This week Year 2 have been learning about 3D shapes and their attributes. They made models of a rectangular prism and labelled the edges, vertices and faces of the shape. We now have an office area in our classroom where the children are able to practice writing, use key boards and do fine motor activities such as drawing and mindful colouring. We were given 5 lovely laptops today and will be using them to enhance learning in all Key Learning areas. To start with the children will be publishing stories and doing spelling and Maths activities with them. Our iPads will also become a more integrated learning tool. The children will use handwriting, spelling and maths apps on these devices more frequently. I am very pleased with the way the writing skills are developing in K-2. Keep up the great work everyone.
