P&C - Special Meeting

The P&C will be holding a Special Meeting on Thursday 1st August 2019, at 6:00pm.

At this meeting a P&C Representative will be appointed to form part of the Merit Selection process for the position of Principal Tarago PS.

At the commencement of this meeting, P&C membership details must be updated. This includes the membership fee of \$1. (Financial membership is a prerequisite for panel consideration and voting rights).

Members are invited to attend this meeting to discuss the selection criteria that will then be taken forward to the first panel meeting.

The P&C Representative will form part of the Merit Selection Panel. The panel will be convened by Mrs Fiona Senior-Conroy, Director Educational Leadership, and include P&C representative, a Principal's representative (from out of area) and a staff representative.

Following a brief panel training process, the panel will meet, generally around 3 hours, and formulate the advertisement for the position. The P&C representative will have the opportunity to offer a

P&C perspective regarding criteria. The ad will then be posted and applications received with a two week turnaround. Following the closing date, panel members will receive a copy of all applications for their consideration. This will be followed by a "short-listing" meeting, where the decision is made regarding which applicants will progress to interview, again approx. 3 hours. The final stage is the interview process, where candidates are interviewed and a decision is formulated. This will take a day.

Pavers
