




News from 3-6

Tarago Public School P&C meeting report

The P&C meeting held yesterday was well attended and we welcomed Miss Jones to her first Tarago P&C meeting. It was with regret that we accepted the resignation of Jacqui Henderson as President and I wish to thank her for all her efforts this year in this position and add a vote of thanks for your help. I was elected to act in the position of President for the remainder of this year.

As there are several administrative processes that need to be worked through with the P&C Federation please contact the committee at this stage through the school email until further notice.

Minutes from last night's meeting will be sent by email shortly to all P&C members, parents and carers. I encourage you to join the P&C as a financial member as this is part of the formal process and allows you to participate in the decision making process. Membership forms are available from our Secretary Lisa Tinson and the cost is \$1.00 per annum. All parents, carers and Tarago community members are eligible to be members of the P&C and all are welcome.

Some of the key points from last night's meeting:-

- Our P&C rep Rod Thiele reported that applications for the Principals position have now closed and the selection and interview process will shortly commence.
- The cabling to the Tarago Learning Centre (old school residence) has been completed
- Miss Jones has been busy installing lights for night access, identifying safety hazards around the school and gaining access to the sporting equipment.
- We appointed Megan Alcock to research and lodge an application to the Federal Government School Community Fund for a grant up to \$20,000 for softfall, replacement shade sails, playground equipment, or payment for excursion buses.
- We have been successful in our application to the Infigen Energy Capital Community Committee Fund for \$2,500 towards the cabling project (total cost \$10,500 plus extras still to be done for connectivity)
- Alternative meeting times and dates for P&C meetings were discussed at length, however Tuesday appears to be the preferred day with 6pm the preferred time by those present. As this does not suit all members to physically attend it was proposed that we use technology for members to phone and/or video call in to attend the meetings.
- Our treasurer will be preparing a budget for our next meeting so we can plan our annual fundraising target.

This is my first time occupying a committee position and I will need help I am sure in the months ahead. We look forward to the many events and opportunities that our students can experience and there will be many opportunities for you to help the school which includes sports, classroom activities and fund raising so please let us know how you can help.
